Short Project Description

Despite their natural resources, Burkina Faso and Mali suffer from food insecurity, which is exacerbated by climate change. Rising food prices, persistently high unemployment and stagnating socio-economic development are leading to growing frustration among the population, particularly among young people. A lack of work and prospects is driving poorly educated young people to the cities and abroad, while there is a shortage of skilled labour in rural areas.

By developing and expanding agricultural vocational training, the project will help to create jobs for these young people, who are currently struggling to earn a living. This will increase the yields of their farms and improve the food security of smallholder families.
