Short Project Description

Burkina Faso has a predominantly rural and young population, many of whom are affected by food insecurity. In addition, climate change is negatively impacting agricultural production and Burkina Faso has been suffering from a security crisis since 2016, which has led to a rapid increase in the number of internally displaced persons.

The project therefore aims to contribute to **improving the living conditions of the population in Burkina Faso**. This is **achieved by strengthening livelihoods, facilitating access to high-quality basic public services and promoting an environment of peace**.

Project Goals

- Strengthening the food security of the population and their resilience to climate change
- Improving access to high-quality basic public services and employment opportunities, particularly for young people and women in rural areas
- Inclusion of internally displaced persons in the above-mentioned activities to strengthen local cohesion
- Equitable distribution of resources by strengthening civil society and developing and respecting participatory and inclusive democratic processes
- Promoting peace, constructive dialogue and social cohesion in the context of municipal and regional developments
